The Nautical Institute's Technical Conference and AGM 2025

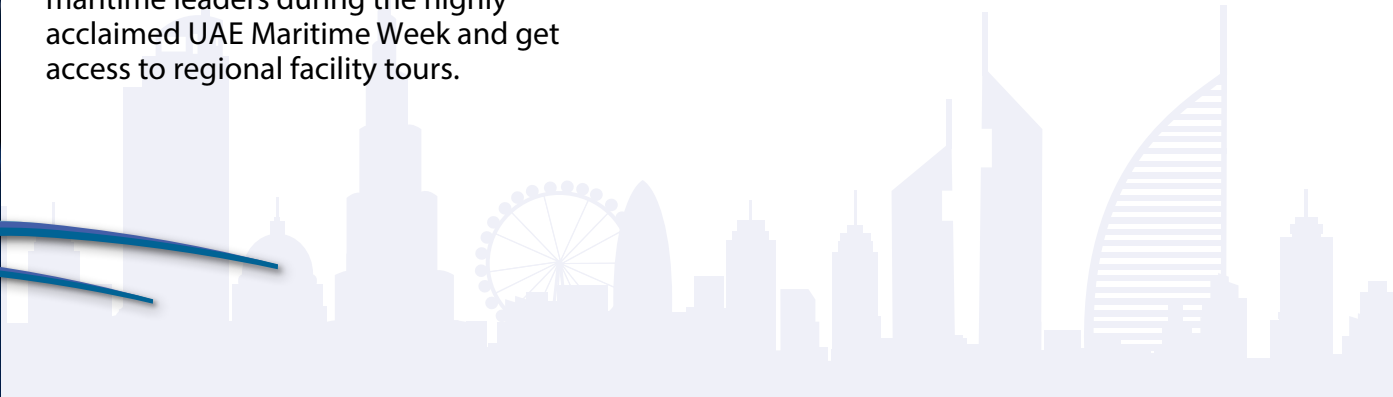
Date and location: 7–8th May, Dubai, UAE

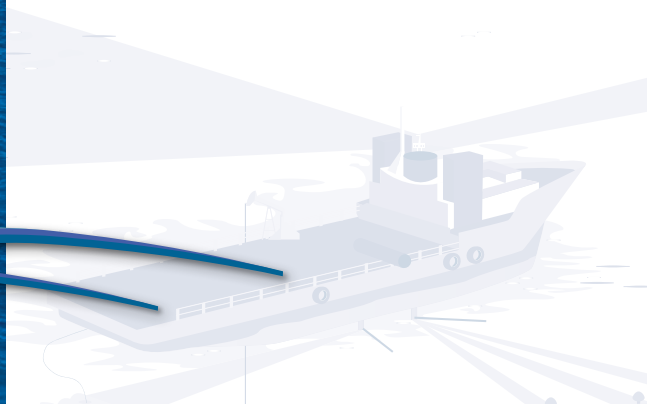
